The family and friends of Robbie Gentry have established this scholarship fund to honor his love of life, family, and business. Scholarships are awarded to deserving Central York High School graduates pursuing a business degree.

Selection Process

The Robbie Gentry Memorial Scholarship is administered by the Employers' Education Foundation as a designated scholarship fund.

The Central York School District may recommend one FEMALE student and one MALE student to the Employers' Education Foundation for consideration of a \$500 scholarship award (2 awards available).

Final selection of the scholarship recipient (s) will be made by the Employers' Education Foundation.

Payment of the scholarship awards will be made directly to the scholarship recipient with a second signature required by the student's school of choice.

Selection Criteria

Central York School District may recommend one FEMALE student and one MALE student. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Grade Point Average – 3.0 or higher
- Admitted to an accredited college, university, or technical/trade school as a full time student.
- Pursuing studies for a career in business.
- Completed a one-page essay describing his/her community activities, personal/academic achievements, and career plans related to business.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from Central York School District faculty member.
